

DATA PROTECTION CLAUSE

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of the General Data Protection Regulation ('GDPR') of 27 April 2016, we hereby notify of the following:

1. Your Personal Data Controller is the company Ogrody Różane Sp. z o.o. ('the Company'), with the registered seat address ul. Mickiewicza 24, 62-500 Konin, Poland.
2. The Company holds a contract for personal data processing by Konimpex-Invest Sp. z o.o. whose Data Protection Officer is Mr. Krzysztof Pietruszewski. Contact data: iod@konimpex.com.pl.
3. Your personal data will be processed in compliance with GDPR:
 - a. to exercise the rights and obligations arising from contracts you have concluded with the Company (GDPR Article 6(1)(a));
 - b. to solicit the Company's range of products (GDPR Article 6(1)(f));
 - c. to exercise the statutory and contractual rights and obligations of the Personal Data Controller applicable to the delivery of projects for which you have concluded a contract with the Personal Data Controller (GDPR Article 6(1)(a)).
4. The recipients of your personal data will also be the entities which cooperate on the delivery of projects and the execution of contracts, including: the General Contractor, a notary public, a legal firm, a building/residential estate manager, IT service providers, accounting service providers, the project financing banks, the escrow account-managing banks (for development contracts), and Konimpex-Invest Sp. z o.o., acting as the manager of the project (including the management of any claims), commercialisation (sales), and archiving.
5. Your personal data will be retained for the following period, as applicable:
 - a. 11 years if the contract is concluded;
 - b. otherwise, 6 months from the end of sale of the project in which you are interested.
6. You have the right to access, rectify, erase, limit the processing and transfer your data as well as the right to object to further processing of your data.
7. If your data is processed under your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the data processing completed before your withdrawal of consent.
8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection whenever you deem the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of GDPR of 27 April 2016.
9. Your submission of your personal data is voluntary yet necessary for presentation of an offer and/or conclusion of the contact. A contract cannot be concluded without the submission of your personal data.

10. Your personal data will not be profiled.
11. Your personal data will not be transmitted to non-EU countries.
